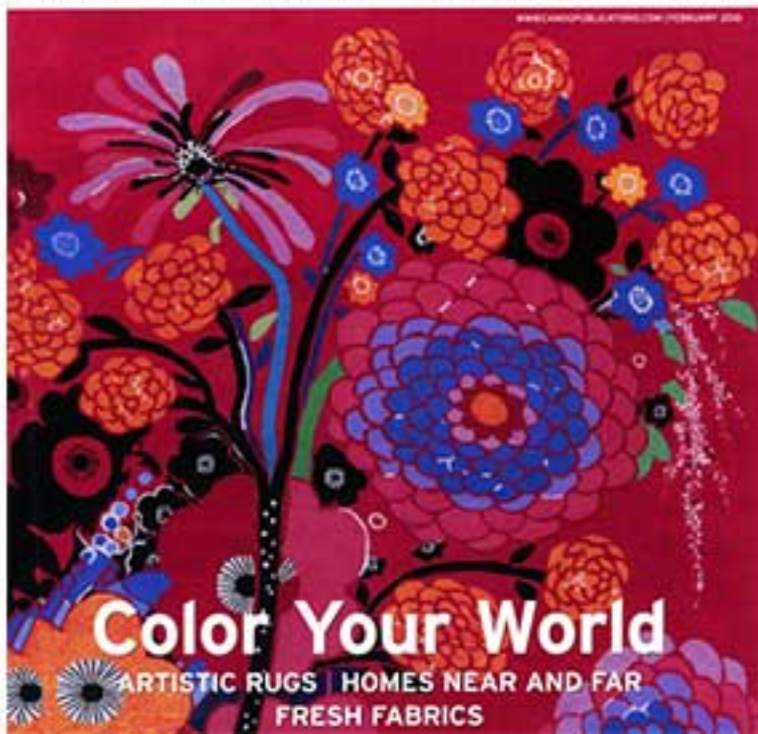

So Soothing | A freestanding tub from Waterworks (see L111) adorns the master bath. **Get The Blues** | Back-painted glass panels and countertops in the master bath (L111) add serenity. The St. Vant limestone flooring is from AKDO; polished-nickel fixtures and hammered sink are from Waterworks. **Pour Me a Cold One** | Custom cabinetry in the bar area (L101) provides plenty of storage for glassware and other accessories and hides a drop-down flat-screen TV. On the counter behind it, a Viking range. Designer Lani Morgan carried the color through to the dining and living rooms. A striking Egyptian hand-blown glass chandelier from Lisa Sherman Antiques is a focal point above the custom pedestal dining table from Circa Antiques, complementing the Palauca "Ballo Chairs" in Crystal Gray and white-washed teak floors.
